In 2000, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the German Federal Ministry of Education and Research (Bundesministerium Für Bildung und Forschung [BMBF]) continued an ongoing partnership to gain an understanding of each other's approach to the cleanup of chemical contamination in order to protect human health and the environment. The Interstate Technology and Regulatory Council (ITRC) is also partnering with EPA in this effort. One product the U.S.-German Bilateral Working Group is developing is SMARTe (Sustainable Management Approaches and Revitalization Tools – electronic).
